24 Hour Crisis HELpline - Crisis intervention, safety planning support, referrals and information throughout Cuyahoga County.

Shelter Services - Safe, confidential emergency shelter and comprehensive programming for women and children who are fleeing domestic violence.

Justice System Advocacy - Assistance for victims involved with the court process. Services include crisis intervention, information, court escorts, advocacy, and emotional support for victims.

Community Support Groups - Free weekly facilitated groups for women and children who have experienced abusive relationships.

Latina Domestic Violence - Comprehensive, bi-lingual, culturally sensitive services focused on facilitating safe options and stability for Latina victims of domestic violence and their children.

Ujima Program - Named after the third Kwanzaa principal meaning "collective work and responsibility" provides professional training and community awareness programs, confidential weekly support groups, advocacy, support and education to women after incarceration.

Supervised Visitation Center- Provides a safe, nurturing environment where children can spend quality time with a non-residential parent when supervision is required.

Counseling for Victims - Comprehensive counseling services for survivors of domestic violence, both adults and children.

Community Education - DVC provides speakers, seminars and trainings on DV to human service, law enforcement, and medical professionals and interested groups in the community.

Volunteer Program - DVC partners with individuals, businesses and groups who lend their time, talent and expertise as volunteers assisting with a range of projects including direct service, clerical and fundraising.

Website - DVC's website offers information about our services, as well as education and awareness for all.

OUR MISSION

To empower individuals, promote justice, and mobilize the community so that all people are free from violence and abuse in their relationships and homes.

PURPOSE

The Domestic Violence Center provides both immediate and long term services to women, men and children who are affected by domestic violence. DVC is part of a community wide effort to respond to victims in the most timely and effective manner. DVC partners with police departments, the justice system, hospitals, social service agencies and individual groups in the community to achieve this goal. The agency provides education and prevention programs to many civic groups and school systems to help raise awareness of domestic violence, prevent domestic violence before it occurs and train others in the skills needed to assist those struggling with domestic violence.
